1/2017 Curriculum modification/suggestion for B.Ed., M.Ed. and M.Phil. programmes (with effect from the academic year 2017-2018)

The Principal Dr. B. C. Sobha presented the curriculum framework and syllabus for the B.Ed., M.Ed. and M.Phil. programmes for the consideration of the Board of Studies with effect from the academic year 2017-2018.

After careful review and elaborate discussions the members suggested the following modifications.

B.Ed.

- 1) Necessary modifications shall be carried out in the content as per their relevance.
- 2) There shall be adequate link between course objectives and learning outcomes of the syllabus.
- 3) The title of the pedagogical course “Development and Dimensions of Education” (Biological Science, English, History, Mathematics and Physical Science) of Semester-II shall be modified as “Development ofEducation”.
- 4) The title of the pedagogic courses “Assessment for Learning” shall be modified as “Assessment of Learning”.
- 5) The title of the DPC course “Yoga for Human Excellence” shall be modified as “Yoga for Professional Excellence”.
- 6) The changes in the DPC course “Drama, Arts and Education” shall be modified accordingly.
- 7) The title of the pedagogic courses “Emerging Trends and Practices in Education (Biological Science, English, History, Mathematics and Physical Science) shall be modified as “Emerging trends inEducation.
- 8) The title of the course shall not be repeated in any of the units as such.
- 9) It was recommend to include the databases *Inflibnet- N list* and *Scopus* in the elective course “Library and Information Science in Education” of Semester-IV.

Resolved to incorporate the suggested modifications in the syllabus of the B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic year 2017-2018 and recommend to the College Academic Council for its approval.

M.Ed.

- 1) Instead of the title of the specialization courses based on hierarchy (Early Childhood, Elementary, Secondary and Higher Secondary and Higher Education) “Prevailing Scenario in Education” of Semester-I, it shall be modified as “Context and Issues in Education”.
- 2) The title of the specialization courses based on discipline (Science, Mathematics, Language, Social Science) of Semester-II shall be modified as “Advanced Methodology inEducation”.
- 3) There shall be adequate link between content and learning outcomes of the syllabus.

Resolved to incorporate the suggested modifications in the syllabus of the M.Ed. programme with effect from the academic year 2017-2018 and recommend to the College Academic Council for its approval.

M.Phil.

- 1) The title of the core course “Advanced Educational Research Methodology and Statistics” of Semester-I shall be modified as “Advanced Educational Research Methodology”.
- 2) There shall be adequate link between content and learning outcomes of the syllabus.

Resolved to incorporate the suggested modifications in the syllabus of the M.Phil. programme with effect from the academic year 2017-2018 and recommend to the College Academic Council for its approval.

2/2017 Panel of Examiners for B.Ed., M.Ed. and M.Phil. programmes for the period 2017-2019

The Principal presented the list of panel of examiners for B.Ed, M.Ed. and M.Phil courses for the period 2017-2019.

Resolved to incorporate the Panel of Examiners for B.Ed., M.Ed. and M.Phil. courses for the period 2017-2019 and recommend to the College Academic Council for its approval.

3/2017 Suggestions of the members

Dr.R.Sahaya Mary, University Nominee advised to add more suggested approaches in a uniform manner in all the courses.

The subject expert *Dr.Amruth G.Kumar* suggested that there should be link between course objectives, learning outcomes and content. He also suggested web resources could be removed from the reference of the syllabus.

Dr.V.Reghu, the subject expert advised to avoid the usage of abbreviations in the content of the syllabus. He also suggested to include evaluation criteria for the assessment of practicals and also for the assessment of suggested activities. He pointed out that the titles of the courses, the titles of the units and their contents shall be corrected accordingly.

Dr. T. Ravichandran, Alumni member suggested to modify the titles of the courses according to the nature of the content.

It was recommended by the members of the *Board of Studies* to place the curriculum framework and syllabus before the *Academic Council* for further discussion.
