**10/2021 Approval of the Minutes of Board of Studies, Academic Council and Finance committee Meetings (for the academic year 2020-21)**

### **13/2021 Action Plan for the year 2021-2022**

Dr. S. Devika, IQAC Co-ordinator presented the Plan of Action for the academic year 2021-2022 which was approved in the meeting.

### **15/2021 Suggestions of the members on Curriculum Enrichment.**

The members of the Governing Body appreciated the reforms and modifications proposed in the curriculum. The management committee nominee **Dr. M.A. Sudheer** (*subject expert*) strongly reiterated to refer *National Professional Standards for Teacher Education* of NCTE guidelines for preparing the curriculum and syllabus. He also emphasized the following suggestions to be incorporated in the curriculum.

- Psychology Experiments is to be included as a practical component in the M.Ed. programme.
- Qualitative analysis is to be introduced and include in the Tool course (Research Methodology) of M.Ed. programme and some software on the qualitative and quantitative analysis shall be installed that will be highly useful for research scholars.
- Research course shall be advanced by incorporating ethnography, narrative analysis and textbook analysis for language students. Mixed method design of study is to be introduced in M.Ed. research course.

**Dr. Sudheer** also opined some important suggestions that shape the future of the student teachers and teacher educands.

- Providing training to the learners through experimental, experiential and exploratory approaches and strategies.

- Conducting case study of the Covid patients among the students and teachers along with action research.
- Digital extension programme shall be planned and implemented that shall give wide exposure to the students and opined to refer the Gandhigram Rural University for adopting this programme.

The UGC nominee *Prof. (Dr.) Nanthana* and the university nominee *Dr. Balakrishnan* appreciated the academic programmes envisioned and appreciated the management and the staff for the efforts in quality maintenance.
