The Principal presented minutes / proceedings of the second academic council meeting held on 29.06.2018, before the members of the academic council.

The council appreciated the teaching faculty for their effort taken for the successful accomplishment of the academic/curricular activities.

6/2019 Confirmation of the Minutes of the second Academic Council Meeting

The meeting resolved to record the confirmation of the minutes of the second academic council meeting.

7 / 2019 Curriculum Modifications / Suggestions for B.Ed., M.Ed. and M. Phil., degree programme (with effect from the academic year 2019-20)

The Member Secretary presented the curriculum framework and syllabus for the B.Ed., M.Ed. and M. Phil. degree programmes for the consideration of the Academic Council with effect from the academic year 2019-20.

After careful review and elaborate discussions, the members of the academic council suggested the following modifications for the **B.Ed. degree programme**.

Dr. C. P. Sreekandan Nair (Subject Expert) suggested that the existing practical component' Psychology practicals' in the second and third semesters is to be re-named as 'Experiments in Psychology.

Dr. K. Rajeswari (subject expert) suggested to modify the practical component 'Test and Measurement' as *Test and Interpretation of Results* in the third semester.

The meeting resolved to incorporate the suggested modifications in the curriculum of the B.Ed. programme with effect from the academic year 2019- 20 and recommend to the College Governing Body for approvel.

Regarding **M.Ed. programme** the Curriculum modifications suggested by the members are the following:

Dr. V. Reghu (subject expert) suggested that separate format is to be prepared for expository writing and instead of removing the tool course 'Capacity Building of Teachers' the crux of the course is to be added in the 'Teacher Education' course as one unit. He also reiterated that 'Lifelong Learning' is to be worded as **3L**.

Prof. (**Dr**). **Mohan Kumar** (subject expert) suggested to modify the fifth unit Self-Science Education in the newly introduced course 'Approaches and Practices in Counselling Psychology' as 'Self Management Education'.

Dr. Indrani and Dr. Meenakshi (university nominees) suggested that the syllabus in the M.Ed., programme should be relevant and in accordance to the NET syllabus.

Mr. Suresh Kumar (subject expert), suggested to conduct a workshop on innovations in teaching and learning.

All the members of the council whole heartedly approved the modified course code and practical code for the B.Ed., M.Ed., and M. Phil., programme with effect from the academic year 2019-20.
